FACILITY/CAPABILITES

Woodland International Research Group is a 12,000-square-foot, 50-inpatient bed research facility designed specifically for the comfort and safety of subjects participating in its clinical trials. The clinical research unit is divided into three clinical areas: an 18-bed private room unit designed to provide privacy and comfort during off PK days, a 16-bed open acute care ward for subjects requiring constant monitoring, and a separate three-room unit with two semi-private beds in each room. All units are equipped with emergency care systems, with nursing stations on each unit which allows visibility to all patients permitting study staff to closely monitor patients. The site has partnered with vendors to provide PET, MRI and CSF sampling capabilities, and utilizes a central IRB for all regulatory submissions. Woodland International Research Group is located approximately five miles from St. Vincent Infirmary Medical Center, and less than one mile from the Arkansas Heart Hospital for emergency care.

Woodland International Research Group recently completed an expansion to include a new 16-bed clinical pharmacology unit. The unit is designed to meet the increased demand for private-based, inpatient facilities devoted to the conduct of complex clinical trials in the pediatric, adolescent and elderly patient populations. The new unit is designed to ensure the best possible care and comfort of these patients, incorporating state-of-the-art technology including bedside TVs, video games, and a large recreation area, as well as a basketball gym. The site also has a dedicated, controlled and secured outdoor smoking space.
