Woodland International Research Group, a subsidiary of Evolution Research Group, is an inpatient/outpatient research facility experienced in conducting simple and complex trials in psychiatric and neurological disorders, pain indications, addictions, sleep disorders as well as additional non-CNS indications. Woodland International Research Group proudly demonstrates leadership in the medical community by offering research to rural and urban areas in Arkansas, as well the surrounding areas in Mississippi, Louisiana, Texas, Oklahoma and Tennessee. Woodland International Research Group has successfully completed more than 200 studies, and was the top enroller on numerous programs.

RESEARCH FACILITY

Woodland International Research Group is a 48-bed research facility. The main research unit is divided into three clinical areas, an 18-bed private room unit designed to provide privacy and comfort, a 10-bed open acute care ward, and a separate unit with two semi-private rooms.

A purpose-built, 16-bed CRU was opened adjacent to the main unit, designed specifically for pediatric and adolescent inpatient trials in special populations. The facility incorporates state-of-theart technology including bedside TVs with video gaming, arts and crafts, gaming tables, an indoor gymnasium, other activities, as well as a secure outdoor fresh air space. Our unit was designed for the comfort of patients and family with two beds per room, which allows caregivers to stay overnight. Our patient retention program includes education and tutoring for school-aged study participants. The staff consists of a board-certified child and adolescent psychiatrist and a board-certified family practitioner also boarded in pain and addiction.

This unit is also being utilized for adult and elderly Phase 1-2a inpatient trials, sleep disorder trials, and more complex studies with smaller cohorts, required serial PK draws, PSG and other specialized procedures allowing separation from the main unit.
